Resurrection Furniture Annual General Meeting 22nd October, 7pm at All Saints Church Hall. Refreshments by Alton Sustainable Eating from 6.30pm. Chairman John Hubbard will present the Annual Report. He will report on an excellent year in the High Street Shop. In particular grants were awarded totalling nearly £50,000 to a wide range of local charities and good causes.

In 2024 we also reached the milestone of giving grants totalling more than £100,000 since the shop opened in 2017.

The AGM will include a guest presentation by Christians Against Poverty (CAP) on the development of their debt relief service, supported by a grant of £11,000 over two years from Resurrection Furniture.
